

Glass: Low Iron / Starphire Transparent Glass Grid: Black Powder Coated Grid

This Clear Starphire/Low Iron GlassWalk SG floor has a black powder coated grid. It provides a distinctive way to display exhibits at the National Archive Building in Washington, DC. Underneath the floor lies a large map of the Gettysburg Battlefield.
